

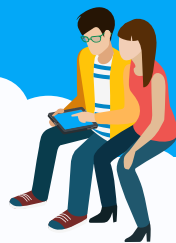

QUESTIONS-ANSWERS

1. To start with, it should be stated that the issue of prison sentences and their effect on the budget is rather controversial. The thing is that on the one hand, there exists a great wish to decrease the number of crimes, and on the other, it is understandable that increased sentences result in greater financial losses for the country. It is really essential to pass new sentences, because it results in the improvement of the balance within the country. However, I consider that the criminals should be in prison. 2. To start with, it should be stated that constitutional correctional system is a system, which presupposes taking the criminal to jail without violation of his civil rights. When the administrator states that he acts constitutionally, it means that he is not involved in allegations of violations of the constitutional and civil rights of the prisoner. The prisoners have to be in a gray area to their legal rights. The prisoners should be constitutionally deprived of their freedom. The key word here is “constitutionally”, which means, that administrator should stick to the law. Even in prison they remain the citizens of the country, and their rights should be respected. Their deprivation of freedom does not allow anybody to violate their civil rights. Administrators should respect their rights (for example right for decent treatment, right or decent health care, etc.) For example, some

defendants cannot leave their houses, this is the violation of their freedom, but their rights on education and health care still remain valid. he prisons. Otherwise, the balance within the country might be wrecked.

3. While discussing the situation with a face wounds, it should be emphasized that in this case, the inmate should definitely obtain medical help from the facility physician or emergency room physician. Plastic surgeon seems to be too expensive. It should be emphasized that the administrator should do everything possible to preserve the health of the inmate, and not taking care about his/her physical appearance. This is not an issue of indifference, but one should understand that today the correctional system experiences great problems. In some states inmates sleep in classrooms, gyms, and corridors, because the prisons are overpopulated. It would be much wiser to spend extra money to the prison's conditions and not to the plastic surgeons.
